## CHRISTMAS CROCHET CHEVRON PILLOW

### Material

- 3 balls of Duna color 8001;
- 1 ball of Duna in each color: 3635 & 5638;
- Crochet hook D3.

### Size

19" x 19"

### Crochet stitch glossary and abbreviations

stitch: st, stitches: sts;

repeat: rep

make: mk

skip: sk

chain: ch,

slip st (sl st)

single crochet (sc)

double crochet (dc)

2dc together: (dc2tog)

Use color 5638. Ch 118 + 3 to turn.

Row 1: insert hook into 4th ch, 9 dc; 2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc in the same base ch; 8 dc, dc2tog; sk 3 sts \*; rep from \* to \* until end of row. Mk 1 dc in the last base ch.

Continue following chart 1, work back & forth, following color sequence. Fasten off.

Make 2 equal parts.

## BUNNY ORNAMENT

### Material

- 1 ball of Amigurumi in each color: 2198, 5767, 3087, 3542 and 8001;
- Crochet hook C2;
- Black safety eyes (8mm);
- Tapestry needle;
- Polyester stuffing.

### Stitch glossary

chain: ch

slip st: sl st

single crochet; sc

Increase: inc

decrease: dec

### Instructions for all patterns

Some of the color switches are made with 1 row in sl st and 1 row in sc, back loop only. Make sure to count them as 2 rows.

Sew with 1 strand of yarn.

Nose and mouth embroideries are made with 2 strands of yarn.

Use color 5442, cut 8 strands (7") in order to hang ornaments.

### Legs (2), body and head

Use color 2198.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

Row 2: 1 sc, 1 inc = 9 sc.

Switch to color 5767.

Row 3: 9 sl st.

Row 4: 9 sc back loop only.

Row 5: 9 sc.

Fasten off.

Make second leg but do not fasten off.

Join legs in the next row.

Switch to color 3542.

Row 6: ch 2, 9 sc in the 1st leg, 2 sc inside ch, 9 sc in the 2nd leg, 2 sc in the other side of ch = 22 sc.

Insert st marker to indicate beginning.

Row 7: 22 sc.

Switch to color 5767..

Row s 8 & 9: 22 sc.

Switch to color 3542.

Row 10: 9 sc, 1 dec = 20 sc.

Row 11: 8 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.

Switch to color 5767.

Row 12: 7 sc, 1 dec = 16 sc.

Row 13: 6 sc, 1 dec = 14 sc.

Switch to color 3542.

Row 14: 5 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.

Switch to color 2198.

Row 15: 12 inc = 24 sc.

Row 16: 5 sc, 1 inc = 28 sc.

Rows 17 - 22: 28 sc.

Insert polyester stuffing inside legs & body.

Row 23: 5 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.

Row 24: 4 sc, 1 dec = 20 sc.

Attach safety eyes between rows 20 & 21, 4 visible sts apart.

Row 25: 3 sc, 1 dec = 16 sc.

Row 26: 2 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.

Insert more polyester stuffing.

Row 27: 6 dec = 6 sc.

Fasten off in magic loop method. (insert needle into front loops of remaining sts and pull tight to close the hole)

Use color 8001 to embroider eye details.

## **Arms (2)**

Use color 2198.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring;

Rows 2 - 4: 6 sc.

Switch to color 5767.

Row 5: 6 sl st.

Row 6: 6 sc back loop only.

Row 7: 6 sc.

Fasten off with a tail to sew.

Do not insert stuffing.

Sew onto side of body.

## **Snout**

Use color 2198.

Row 1: 7 sc inside of magic ring.

Row 2: 7 inc = 14 sc.  
Fasten off leaving a tail to sew.  
Use color 3087 to embroider nose & mouth.  
Sew onto head.

### **Ears (2)**

Use color 2198.  
Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring  
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc.  
Rows 3 - 5: 12 sc.  
Row 6: 4 sc, 1 dec = 10 sc.  
Rows 7 & 8: 10 sc.  
Row 9: 3 sc, 1 dec = 8 sc.  
Row 10: 8 sc.  
Fasten off.  
Insert stuffing.  
Sew onto head.

### **Tail**

Use color 2198.  
Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring  
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc.  
Fasten off.  
Do not insert stuffing.  
Sew onto body.

## SQUIRREL ORNAMENT

### Material

- 1 ball of Amigurumi in each color: 7625, 5767, 3542, 8001, 8990 and 7096;
- Crochet hook C2;
- Black safety eyes (8mm);
- Tapestry needle;
- Polyester stuffing.

### Stitch glossary

Stitch glossary:

chain: ch

slip st; sl st

single crochet; sc

Increase: inc

decrease: dec

### Instructions for all patterns

Some of the color switches are made with 1 row in sl st and 1 row in sc, back loop only. Make sure to count them as 2 rows.

Sew with 1 strand of yarn.

Nose and mouth embroideries are made with 2 strands of yarn.

Use color 5442, cut 8 strands (7") in order to hang ornaments.

## Legs (2), body & head

Use color 7625.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

Row 2: 1 sc, 1 inc = 9 sc.

Switch to color 5767.

Row 3: 9 sl st.

Row 4: 9 sc back loop only.

Row 5: 9 sc.

Fasten off.

Make second leg but do not fasten off.

Join legs in the next row:

Row 6: ch 2, 9 sc in the 1st leg, 2 sc inside ch, 9 sc in the 2nd leg, 2 sc in the other side of ch = 22 sc.

Insert st marker to indicate beginning.

Rows 7 & 8: 22 sc.

Switch to color 3542.

Row 9; 22 sc.

Row 10: 9 sc, 1 dec = 20 sc.

Row 11: 8 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.

Row 12: 7 sc, 1 dec = 16 sc.

Row 13: 6 sc, 1 dec = 14 sc.

Row 14: 5 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.

Switch to color 7625.

Row 15: 12 inc = 24 sc.

Row 16: 5 sc, 1 inc = 28 sc.

Rows 17 - 22: 28 sc.

Insert polyester stuffing inside legs & body.

Row 23: 5 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.

Row 24: 4 sc, 1 dec = 20 sc.

Attach safety eyes between rows 20 & 21, 4 visible sts apart.

Row 25: 3 sc, 1 dec = 16 sc.

Row 26: 2 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.

Insert more polyester stuffing.

Row 27: 6 dec = 6 sc.

Fasten off in magic loop method. (insert needle into front loops of remaining sts and pull tight to close the hole)

Use color 8001 to embroider eye details.

## Arms (2)

Use color 7625.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring;

Rows 2 - 4: 6 sc.

Switch to color 3542.

Row 5: 6 sl st.

Row 6: 6 sc back loop only.

Row 7: 6 sc.

Fasten off with a tail to sew.

Do not insert stuffing.

Sew onto side of body.

### **Snout**

Use color 7625.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

Row 2: 1 sc, 1 inc = 9 sc.

Row 3: 2 sc, 1 inc = 12 sc.

Row 4: 3 sc, 1 inc = 15 sc.

Fasten off with a tail to sew.

Use color 8990 to embroider nose & mouth.

Use color 8001 to embroider teeth.

Insert stuffing.

Sew onto head.

Use color 7096 to embroider details on snout.

### **Ears (2)**

Use color 7625.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring

Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc.

Fasten off.

Fold and sew edge.

Sew ears on side of head

### **Tail**

Use color 7625.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

Row 2: 1 sc, 1 inc = 9 sc.

Row 3: 2 sc, 1 inc = 12 sc.

Row 4: 4 sc, 1 dec = 10 sc.

Row 5: 3 sc, 1 dec = 8 sc.

Row 6: 2 sc, 1 dec = 6 sc.

Rows 7 & 8: 6 sc.

Fasten off.

Insert stuffing, and sew onto body facing up.

### Material

- 1 ball of Amigurumi in each color: 3635, 7062, 8990 and 8001;
- Crochet hook B1;
- Tapestry needle;
- Polyester stuffing.

### Stitch glossary

chain: ch

slip st; sl st

single crochet; sc

Increase: inc

decrease: dec

### Instructions for all patterns

Some of the color switches are made with 1 row in sl st and 1 row in sc, back loop only. Make sure to count them as 2 rows.

Sew with 1 strand of yarn.

Nose and mouth embroideries are made with 2 strands of yarn.

Use color 5442, cut 8 strands (7") in order to hang ornaments.

### Legs (2), body & head

Use color 8990.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

Row 2: 1 sc, 1 inc = 9 sc.

Row 3: 9 sc.

Switch to color 3635.

Row 4: 9 sl st.

Row 5: 9 sc back loop only.

Fasten off.

Make second leg but do not fasten off.

Join legs in the next row:

Row 6: ch 2, 9 sc in the 1st leg, 2 sc into ch, 9 sc in the 2nd leg, 2 sc into other side of ch = 22 sc.

Insert st marker to indicate beginning.

Rows 7 & 8: 22 sc.

Switch to color 8990.

Row 9: 22 sc.

Switch to color 3635.

Row 10: 9 sc, 1 dec = 20 sc.

Row 11: 8 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.

Row 12: 7 sc, 1 dec = 16 sc.

Row 13: 6 sc, 1 dec = 14 sc.

Row 14: 5 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.

Switch to color 7062.

Row 15: 12 inc = 24 sc.

Row 16: 5 sc, 1 inc = 28 sc.

Rows 17 - 22: 28 sc.

Insert polyester stuffing inside legs & body.

Row 23: 5 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.

Row 24: 4 sc, 1 dec = 20 sc.

Row 25: 3 sc, 1 dec = 16 sc.

Row 26: 2 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.

Insert more polyester stuffing.

Row 27: 6 dec = 6 sc.

Fasten off in magic loop method. (insert needle into front loops only of remaining sts and pull tight to close the hole)

## Arms (2)

Use color 7062.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring;

Rows 2 - 4: 6 sc.

Switch to color 3635.

Row 5: 6 sl st.

Row 6: 6 sc back loop only.

Row 7: 6 sc.

Fasten off with a tail to sew.

Do not insert stuffing.

Sew onto side of body.

## Hat

Use color 3635.

Row 1: 4 sc inside of magic ring.

Row 2: 1 sc, 1 inc = 6sc.

Rows 3 & 4: 6 sc.

Row 5: 2 sc, 1 inc = 8 sc.

Row 6: 8 sc.

Row 7: 3 sc, 1 inc = 10 sc.

Row 8: 10 sc.

Row 9: 4 sc, 1 inc = 12 sc.

Row 10: 12 sc.

Row 11: 5 sc, 1 inc = 14 sc.

Row 12: 14 sc.  
Row 13: 6 sc, 1 inc = 16 sc.  
Row 14: 16 sc.  
Row 15: 7 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.  
Row 16: 18 sc.  
Row 17: 8 sc, 1 inc = 20 sc.  
Row 18: 9 sc, 1 inc = 22 sc.  
Row 19: 10 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.  
Row 20: 11 sc, 1 inc = 26 sc.  
Row 21: 12 sc, 1 inc = 28 sc.  
Row 22: 13 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc.  
Row 23: 14 sc, 1 inc = 32 sc.  
Rows 24 - 39: 32 sc.  
Fasten off.  
Do not insert stuffing.

### **Hair**

Use color 8001.  
Cut 30 strands (7").  
Use 1 strand and make a knot in each st from row 22. Use dog brush to comb hair.

### **Nose**

Use color 7062.  
Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.  
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc.  
Row 3: 3 sc, 1 inc = 15 sc.  
Row 4: 1 sc, 1 dec = 10 sc.  
Insert stuffing.  
Row 5: 5 dec = 5 sc.  
Fasten off in magic loop method. (insert needle into front loops of remaining sts and pull tight to close the hole)  
Sew nose between rows 18 & 20.  
Glue hair and beard. Trim beard to create edge. Sew hat on head.

### Material

- 1 ball of Amigurumi in each color: 5767, 7529, 3542, 8990 and 8001;
- Crochet hook B1;
- Black safety eyes (8mm);
- Tapestry needle;
- Polyester stuffing.

### Stitch glossary

chain: ch

slip st; sl st

single crochet; sc

Increase: inc

decrease: dec

### Instructions for all patterns

Some of the color switches are made with 1 row in sl st and 1 row in sc, back loop only. Make sure to count them as 2 rows.

Sew with 1 strand of yarn.

Nose and mouth embroideries are made with 2 strands of yarn.

Use color 5442, cut 8 strands (7") to hang ornaments.

### Legs (2), body & head

Use color 8990.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

Row 2: 1 sc, 1 inc = 9 sc.

Switch to color 5767.

Row 3: 9 sl st.

Row 4: 9 sc back loop only.

Row 5: 9 sc.

Fasten off.

Make second leg but do not fasten off.

Join legs in the next row:

Row 6: ch 2, 9 sc in the 1st leg, 2 sc into ch, 9 sc in the 2nd leg, 2 sc into other side of ch = 22 sc.

Insert st marker to indicate beginning.

Rows 7 - 9: 22 sc.

Row 10: 9 sc, 1 dec = 20 sc.

Row 11: 8 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.

Row 12: 7 sc, 1 dec = 16 sc.

Row 13: 6 sc, 1 dec = 14 sc.

Row 14: 5 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.

Switch to color 8001.

Row 15: 12 inc = 24 sc.

Row 16: 5 sc, 1 inc = 28 sc.

Rows 17 - 19: 28 sc.

Switch to color 7529.

Row 20: 28 sc.

Insert polyester stuffing inside legs & body.

Row 21: 5 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.

Row 22: 4 sc, 1 dec = 20 sc.

Attach eyes between rows 20 & 21, 4 visible sts apart.

Row 23: 3 sc, 1 dec = 16 sc.

Row 24: 2 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.

Insert more polyester stuffing.

Row 25: 6 dec = 6 sc.

Fasten off in magic loop method. (insert needle into front loops of remaining sts and pull tight to close the hole)

Use color 8001 to embroider eye detail and color 3542 to embroider body onto row 9.

## **Arm (2)**

Use color 8990.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring;

Row 2: 6 sc.

Switch to color 7529.

Rows 3 7 4: 6 sc.

Switch to color 5767.

Row 5: 6 sl st.

Row 6: 6 sc back loop only.

Row 7: 6 sc.

Fasten off leaving a tail to sew.

Do not insert stuffing.

Sew onto side of body.

## **Snout**

Use color 8001.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc.

Row 3: 5 sc, 1 inc = 14 sc.  
Fasten off leaving a tail to sew.  
Use color 8990 to embroider nose and mouth.  
Insert stuffing and sew onto head.

### **Ears (2)**

Use color 7529

Ch 12 and close with a sl st..

Row 1: 4 sc, 1 dec = 10 sc.

Row 2: 3 sc, 1 dec = 8 sc.

Row 3: 2 sc, 1 dec = 6 sc.

Row 4: 1 sc, 1 dec = 4 sc.

Fasten off in magic loop method. (insert needle into front loops of remaining sts and pull tight to close the hole)

Do not insert stuffing.

Sew ears onto head.

Use color 8990 to embroider detail on the edge of ears.

### **Tail**

Use color 8001.

Row 1: 4 sc inside of magic ring.

Row 2: 1 sc, 1 inc = 6 sc.

Row 3: 2 sc, 1 inc = 8 sc.

Switch to color 7529.

Row 4: 3 sc, 1 dec = 10 sc.

Row 5: 10 sc.

Row 6: 3 sc, 1 dec = 8 sc.

Row 7: 2 sc, 1 dec = 6 sc.

Fasten off.

Insert stuffing, and sew onto body.

- 1 ball of Amigurumi in each color: 7727, 3542, 5767, 7569 and 8001;
- Crochet hook B1;
- Black safety eyes (8mm);
- Tapestry needle;
- Polyester stuffing.

### Stitch glossary

chain: ch

slip st; sl st

single crochet; sc

Increase: inc

decrease: dec

### Instructions for all patterns

Some of the color switches are made with 1 row in sl st and 1 row in sc, back loop only. Make sure to count them as 2 rows.

Sew with 1 strand of yarn.

Nose and mouth embroideries are made with 2 strands of yarn.

Use color 5442, cut 8 strands (7") to hang ornaments.

### Legs (2), body & head.

Use color 8990.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

Row 2: 1 sc, 1 dec = 9 sc.

Switch to color 3542.

Row 3: 9 sl st.

Row 4: 9 sc back loop only.

Row 5: 9 sc.

Fasten off.

Make second leg but do not fasten off.

Join legs in the next row:

Row 6: ch 2, 9 sc in the 1st leg, 2 sc into ch, 9 sc in the 2nd leg, 2 sc into other side of ch = 22 sc.

Rows 7 & 8: 22 sc.

Switch to color 5767.

Row 9: 22 sc.

Row 10: 9 sc, 1 dec = 20 sc.

Row 12: 7 sc, 1 dec = 16 sc.

Row 13: 6 sc, 1 dec = 14 sc.

Row 14: 5 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.

Fasten off leaving a tail to sew.

Do not insert stuffing.

Sew onto side of body.

## **Snout**

Use color 7727.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring;

Row 2: 1sc, 1 inc = 9 sc.

Row 3: 2 sc, 1 inc = 12 sc.

Row 4: 3 sc, 1 inc = 15 sc.

Fasten off leaving a tail to sew.

Use color 7569 to embroider nose and mouth.  
Insert stuffing and sew onto head.

### **Ears (2)**

Use color 7727.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc.

Fasten off.

Fold in half and sew on side of head.

### **Horns (2)**

Use color 7569.

Ch 5.

Row 1: sk 1 ch, 2 sl st, ch 3, sk 1 ch, turn 2 sl st, 2 sl st in the initial chains.

Fasten off and sew on top of head.

### **Tail**

Use color 7727.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

Row 2: 6 sc.

Fasten off.

Do not insert stuffing.

Sew onto body.

## Material

- 1 ball of Amigurumi in each color: 3528, 5767 and 8001;
- Styrofoam ball - 3.25 diameter;
- Crochet hook D3;

## Stitch glossary

chain: ch

slip st; sl st

single crochet; sc

Increase: inc

decrease: dec

Use color 8001.

3 chains to turn are considered 1 dc. Close rows with a sl st.

Row 1: 12 dc inside magic ring = 12 dc.

Row 2: 12 inc = 24 dc.

Switch to color 3528.

Row 3: 1 inc, 1 dc = 36 dc.

Switch to color 5767.

Row 4: 1 inc, 2 dc = 48 dc.

Switch to color 3528.

Row 5: 1 elongated dc, 3 sc = 48 sts

Row 6: 48 sc.

Switch to color 5767.

Rows 7 & 8: 48 sc.

Mk 2 parts. Join parts with sl sts.  
Ch 30 and close with a sl st into 1st ch.  
Fasten off.

### Ornament cap


Use color 3528.

Row 1: 10 dc inside of magic ring. Close with a sl st. Insert the cord made with 30 ch through ring and glue on ball.

- 1 ball of Amigurumi - colors 3528, 8001, 5767 and 4456;
- Crochet hook D3;
- Black safety eyes 8 mm;
- Fabric glue;
- Polyester stuffing;

### Crochet stitch glossary and abbreviations

stitch: st, stitches: sts;

repeat: rep

chain: ch,

slip stitch: sl st,

single crochet (sc),

half double crochet (hdc)

double crochet (dc),

decrease: dec

increase: inc

make: mk

skip: sk

### Head

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc.

Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.

Row 4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.

Row 5: (back loop only) 3 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc.

Row 6: 4 sc, 1 inc = 36 sc.

Row 7: 5 sc, 1 inc = 42 sc.

Row 8: 6 sc, 1 inc = 48 sc.

Rows 9 - 17: 48 sc.

Attach eyes between rows 16 & 17, 8 sts apart.

Row 18: 6 sc, 1 dec = 42 sc.

Row 19: 5 sc, 1 dec = 36 sc.

Row 20: 4 sc, 1 dec = 30 sc.

Row 21: 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.

Row 22: 2 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.

Insert stuffing.

Row 23: 1 dc, 1 dec = 12 sc.

Fasten off with sl st.

Fasten off in magic loop method. (insert needle into front loops of remaining sts and pull tight to close the hole)

### **Nose**

Use color 8001.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

Row 2: 2 sc, 1 inc = 8 sc.

Row 3: 8 sc.

Fasten off in sl st, leaving a tail to sew.

### **Beanie**

Use color 5767.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc.

Rows 3 & 4: 12 sc.

Insert stuffing.

Row 6: 6 inc = 12 sc.

Row 7: 12 sc.

Row 8: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.

Row 9: 18 sc.

Row 10: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.

Row 11: 24 sc.

Row 12: 3 sc, 1 dec = 30 sc.

Row 13: 30 sc.

Row 14: 4 sc, 1 inc = 36 sc.

Row 15: 36 sc.

Row 16: 5 sc, 1 inc = 42 sc.

Row 17: 42 sc.

Row 18: 6 sc, 1 inc = 48 sc.

Rows 19 - 21: 48 sc.

Switch to color 5767.

Row 22: 48 sc.

Row 23: Crab st (sc from left to right)

Fasten off.

### **Scarf**

Use color 3528.

Ch 10. Work back & forth.

Row 1: sk 1 ch, 9 sc (back loop only), turn.

Row 2: ch1, 9 sc (back loop only).

Switch to color 5767.

Row 3: ch 1, 9 sc (back loop only)

Row 4: ch 1, 9 sc (back loop only)

Continue working until row 39, switching colors every 2 rows.

Fasten off leaving a tail to sew.

Close scarf making a circle.

Sew scarf (WS) onto front loops of 5th row.

Fold in half for finishing.

### **Assembly**

Tips:

Leave seams facing back.

Sew nose between eyes proportionally.

Glue beanie on head.

Use black Clea (double yarn) to embroider eyebrows and mouth





- 2 balls of Natural Cotton Maxcolor 4/6 colors 3501 & 7259;
- 1 ball of Natural Cotton Maxcolor 4/6 5767;
- Crochet hook G-6.

**Size:** 61" x 35.5"

### Stitch glossary and abbreviations

stitch: st

make: mk

skip: sk

chain: ch

slip st: sl st

single crochet; sc

half double crochet: hdc

Increase: inc

decrease: dec

This blanket is worked in tapestry crochet. Tapestry crochet is done by carrying two colors or more in each row, switching colors according to chart. Work one color at a time, while keeping the other colors inside stitches (st) throughout the work.

In this technique the color is changed in the last 3 loops (yarn over) of stitch. Work with a new color and carry the other inside stitches. In a correct color change, you have a hdc in a solid color and a new color on your hook. Each space

in the chart represents 1 hdc.

### Chart 1

Use color 8001 and ch 159 + 2 to turn.

Row 1: insert hook in the 3rd ch, 159 hdc. Cut yarn.

Row 2: join color 5767, ch 2 + 159 hdc.

Row 3: join color 3402, put yarn on the top of previous row and use color 5767.

Ch 2, 3 hdc, leave 3 loops in the hook, \* put color 5767 on the top of previous row, use color 3402 to finish the 3 loops; mk 3 hdc, leave 3 loops on the hook; put color 3402 on the top of previous row; finish the 3 loops with color 5767; mk 3 hdc\*; rep from \* to \* until the end of row.

Continue following chart 1, switching colors accordingly. Fasten off.

### Chart 2 - Finishing

Join color 7259 on the corner.

Row 1: ch 3, mk 2 dc in the same base st; \*skip 3 base sts; 1 sc, ch 2, 2 dc in the same base st\*; rep from \* to \* around blanket. Close with 1 sl st. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Row 1: Ch 4, turn, 1 sc in each ch, sl st in the base

Row 2: 1 sl st in the next base st, turn, 3 sc, 2 sc inc, turn

Row 3: 2 sc in the 1 st sc, 3 sc, 1 sl st in the base, 1 sl st in the next base st, turn

Row 4: 4 sc, 2 sc inc, turn

Row 5: 2 sc inc, 4 sc, 1 sl st in the base, 1 sl st in the next base st, turn

Row 6: Row 6: 4 sc, turn

Row 7: 1 picot and 1 sc in the first ch, 2 sc, 1 picot and from now on make 3 sc, 1 picot around hairband and on other holy leaf edge.

### Holly berry (make 3)

Ch 6, 5 dc in the 5th ch, 1 dc, insert hook into the first dc

Close

Remember to leave a long tail to start and finish and use them to tie berries on leaves.

Tie them all together and then on the ring.

Note: this coaster starts with 2 strands of 8176

Row 1: 12 dc inside of magic ring

Row 2: 12 inc = 24 dc (if it curls up make 1 extra dc before closing row)

Switch to green 5795 and mk \*1 sc in ch space and ch on sc\*

Make holly leaves and berry same as ring.



Row 5: ch 3, 2 dc, 1 inc; \*3 dc, 1 inc\*; rep from \* to \* (12x more). Close with a sl st.

Row 6: ch 3, 3 dc, 1 inc; \*4 dc, 1 inc\*; rep from \* to \* (12x more). Close with a sl st.

Row 7: ch 3, 4 dc, 1 inc; \*5 dc, 1 inc\*; rep from \* to \* (12x more). Close with a sl st.

Row 8: ch 3, 5 dc, 1 inc; \*6 dc, 1 inc\*; rep from \* to \* (12x more). Close with a sl st.  
Row 9: ch 3, 6 dc, 1 inc; \*7 dc, 1 inc\*; rep from \* to \* (12x more). Close with a sl st.  
Row 10: ch 3, 7 dc, 1 inc; \*8 dc, 1 inc\*; rep from \* to \* (12x more). Close with a sl st.  
Row 11: 1 sl st in each base st, back loop only.  
Row 12: ch 7, skip 3 sts; \* 1 dc, ch 4, skip 3 sts\* rep from \* to \* until the end of row.  
Close with 1 sl st in the 3rd initial ch.

### **Tulips**

Row 13: \*ch 4, 1 dc in the next st, forming a small loop; turn to WS and work in this small loop, ch 1, 3 dc, 1 picot ( ch3 close with a sl st in the initial ch); 3 dc, turn to the RS, 5 dc on the side of dc from previous row; 1 sc in the next dc; \* rep from \* to \* until the end of row. Close with a sl st. Fasten off.  
Glue one pearl on each picot.

### **Leaves**

Row 14: Switch to color 5638 and join in one of the loops on back of tulips, start with 1 sc \*ch 5, 1 sc in the next tulip, \* rep from \* to \* until the end of row. Close with a sl st.  
Row 15: mk 1 sl st into the 1st loop; ch 3, 2 dc, 1 picot, 3 dc \* in the next loop, mk 3 dc, 1 picot, 3 dc; \* rep from \* to \* until the end of row. Close with a sl st and fasten off.



