TEDDY BEAR - amigurumi crochet pattern.

Materials:
Worsted weight yarn, approximately 150 yards
$4 \mathrm{~mm}(\mathrm{G})$ hook
$2 \times 15 \mathrm{~mm}$ safety eyes
$1 \times 13 \mathrm{~mm}$ safety nose (or black embroidery floss)
Yarn needle
Poly-fil
Size: 8 " sitting, 10 " standing when made with the suggested yarn and hook size.
Stitch abbreviations
MR: magic ring
$\mathrm{St}(\mathrm{s}):$ stitch(es)
Sc: single crochet
Inc: single crochet inc
Dec: single crochet dec
(): repeat same stitches
[: stitches in same stitch
BLO: crochet in back loop only
FO: fasten off

Pattern is worked in continuous rounds.

## BODY AND HEAD

Make 1.
Stuff as you go.
Round 1: Sc x 7 in MR (7)
Round 2: Sc inc x 7 (14)
Round 3: (Sc x 1, sc inc $\times 1$ ) $\times 7$ (21)
Round 4: (Sc $\times 2$, sc inc $\times 1$ ) $\times 7$ (28)
Round 5: (Sc $\times 3$, sc inc $\times 1$ ) $\times 7$ (35)
Round 6: (Sc x 4, sc inc $\times 1$ ) $\times 7$ (42)
Rounds 7-14: Sc x 42 (42)
Round 15: (Sc x 5, sc dec x 1) x 6 (36)
Rounds 16-17: Sc x 36 (36)
Round 18: (Sc x 4, sc dec x 1) x 6 (30)
Rounds 19-20: Sc x 30 (30)
Round 21: (Sc x 3, sc dec x 1) x 6 (24) Rounds 22-23: Sc x 24 (24) Stuff the body.
Round 24: (Sc x 1, sc inc x 1) x 12 (36)
Round 25: (Sc x 5, sc inc $\times 1$ ) $\times 6$ (42)
Round 26: (Sc x 6, sc inc $\times$ 1) $\times 6$ (48)
Round 27: (Sc x 7, sc inc x 1) x 6 (54)
Rounds 28-37: Sc x 54 (54)
Insert safety eyes between rounds 33 \& 34, 9 sts apart.
Round 38: (Sc x 7, sc dec $\times 1$ ) $\times 6$ (48)
Round 39: (Sc x 6, sc dec x 1) x 6 (42)
Round 40: (Sc x 5, sc dec x 1) x 6 (36)

Round 41: (Sc x 4, sc dec x 1) x 6 (30)
Round 42: (Sc $\times 3$, sc dec $\times 1$ ) $\times 6$ (24)
Round 43: (Sc x 2, sc dec x 1) x 6 (18)
Round 44: (Sc x 1, sc dec x 1) x 6 (12)
Round 45: Sc dec x 6 (6)
FO, whip stitch through FLO and pull tight to close. Weave in ends.

## LEGS

Make 2.
Round 1: Sc x 6 in MR (6)
Round 2: Sc inc x 6 (12)
Round 3: (Sc $\times 1$, sc inc $\times 1$ ) $\times 6$ (18)
Round 4: (Sc x 2, sc inc $\times 1$ ) $\times 6$ (24)
Round 5: (Sc x 3, sc inc $\times 1$ ) $\times 6$ (30)
Round 6: Sc x 30 BLO (30)
Rounds 7-8: Sc x 30 (30)
Round 9: Sc x 6, (sc dec $\times 1, \operatorname{sc} \times 1$ ) $\times 5$, sc $\operatorname{dec} \times 1, \operatorname{sc} \times 7$ (24)
Round 10: (Sc x 2, sc dec x 1) x 6 (18)
Rounds 11-13: Sc x 18 (18)
Round 14: (Sc x 7, sc dec x 1) x 2 (16)
Rounds 15-19: Sc x 16 (16)
Round 20: Stuff the leg about $3 / 4$ of the way, leaving the top unstuffed. Pinch closed and sc $\times 8$ across the top of the leg.
FO, leaving a long tail for sewing.
Sew to the bottom of the body.

## ARMS

Make 2.
Round 1: Sc x 6 in MR (6)
Round 2: Sc inc x 6 (12)
Round 3: (Sc x 1, sc inc $\times 1$ ) $\times 6$ (18)
Round 4: (Sc x 2, sc inc x 1) x 6 (24)
Rounds 5-8: Sc x 24 (24)
Round 9: (Sc x 2, sc dec x 1) x 6 (18)
Round 10: Sc x 18 (18)
Round 11: (Sc x 4, sc dec x 1) x 3 (15)
Round 12: Sc x 15 (15)
Round 13: (Sc x 3, sc dec x 1) x 3 (12)
Rounds 14-18: Sc x 12 (12)
Round 19: Stuff, the arm about $3 / 4$ of the way, leaving the top unstuffed. Pinch closed and sc $\times 6$ across, closing the top of the leg.
FO, leaving long tail for sewing. Sew to the sides of the body, 1 round under the head.

MUZZLE
Make 1
Round 1: Ch 6, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc x 3, [sc x 3] in next st, working on the opposite side of the ch, sc $x$ 3, sc inc $x 1$ (12)
Round 2: sc inc $x$ 1, sc $x$ 3, sc inc $x 3$, sc $x 3$, sc inc $x 2$ (18)
Round 3: (Sc x 2, sc inc $\times 1$ ) $\times 6$ (24)
Rounds 4-6: Sc x 24 (24)
FO, leaving a tail for sewing. Insert safety nose.
Sew to the face, adding some stuffing before you close.
Alternatively, you can embroider the nose using black embroidery floss.

## EARS

Make 2.
Round 1: Sc $x 6$ in MR (6)
Round 2: Sc inc x 6 (12)
Round 3: (Sc $\times 1$, sc inc $\times 1$ ) $\times 6$ (18)
Round 4: (Sc $\times 2$, sc inc $\times 1$ ) $\times 6$ (24)
Rounds 5-7: Sc x 24(24)
Round 8: (Sc x 4, sc dec $\times 1$ ) $\times 4$ (20)
Round 9: Sc x 20 (20)
FO, leaving tail for sewing.
Flatten the ears (do not stuff) and sew to the head on either side.
