

Instructions for Foundation Crochet

1. Chain 2. Insert hook into second chain from hook. Yarn over and pull up a loop. **[2 loops]**
2. Yarn over and pull through the first loop on hook i.e. ch 1. This is the extra "chain" in your foundation row. **[Still 2 loops on hook]**
3. Yarn over and pull through the two remaining loops on your hook. First fsc made.
4. Insert hook into extra "chain" made in Step 2. Yarn over and pull up a loop. **[2 loops on hook]**
5. Yarn over and pull through the first loop on hook i.e. ch 1. This is the next "chain" in your foundation row. Yarn over and pull through the two loops on your hook. Second fsc made.
6. Repeat Steps 4 and 5 until desired row length is reached.

NOTE: if your pattern calls for you to chain 41 stitches and sc into each one for your first row, then fsc 40 stitches. Foundation sc (fsc) or fhdc or fdc always one less stitch than called for in the pattern.

Instructions for fhdc and fdc

1. Chain 2. Yarn over and insert hook into second chain from hook. Yarn over and pull up a loop. **[3 loops on hook]**
2. Yarn over and pull through the first loop on hook i.e. ch 1. This is the extra "chain" in your foundation row. **[Still 3 loops on hook]**
3. Yarn over and pull through the three loops on your hook. First fhdc made. If you are doing fdc then pull through 2 loops and then 2 loops as in regular dc.

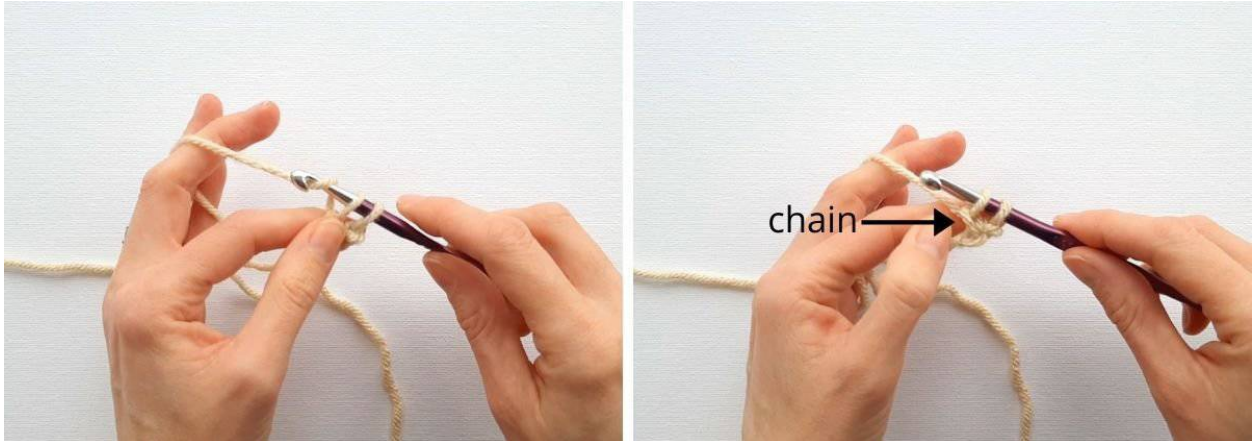
4. Yarn over and insert hook into extra "chain" made in Step 2. Yarn over and pull up a loop. **[3 loops on hook]**
5. Yarn over and pull through the first loop on hook i.e. ch 1. This is the next "chain" in your foundation row. Yarn over and pull through the 3 loops on your hook. Second fhdc made. If you are doing fdc then pull through 2 loops and then 2 loops as in regular dc.
6. Repeat Steps 4 and 5 until desired row length is reached.

VISUAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR FSC

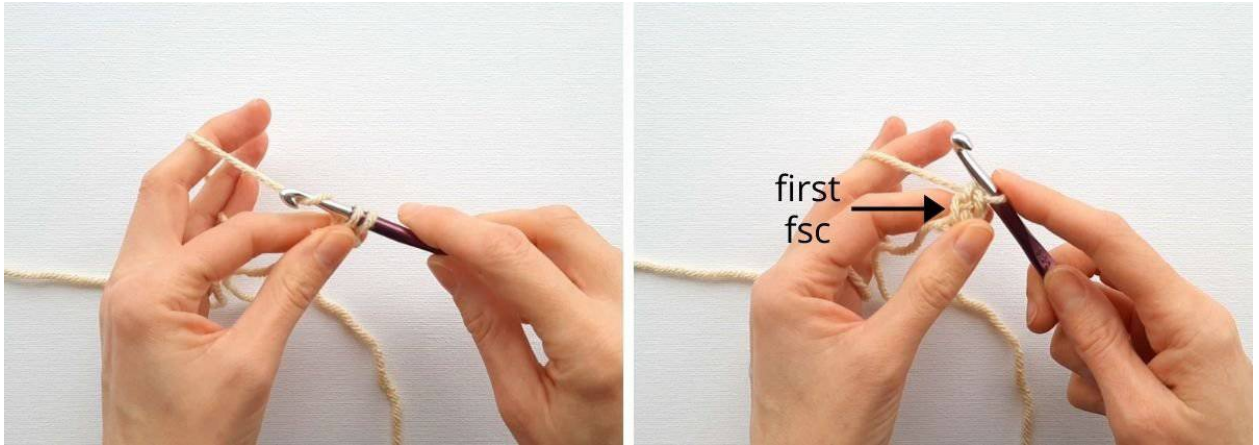
1. Chain 2. Insert hook into second chain from hook. Yarn over and pull up a loop. **[2 loops on hook]**



2. Yarn over and pull through the first loop on hook i.e. ch 1. This is the extra "chain" in your foundation row. **[2 loops on hook]**



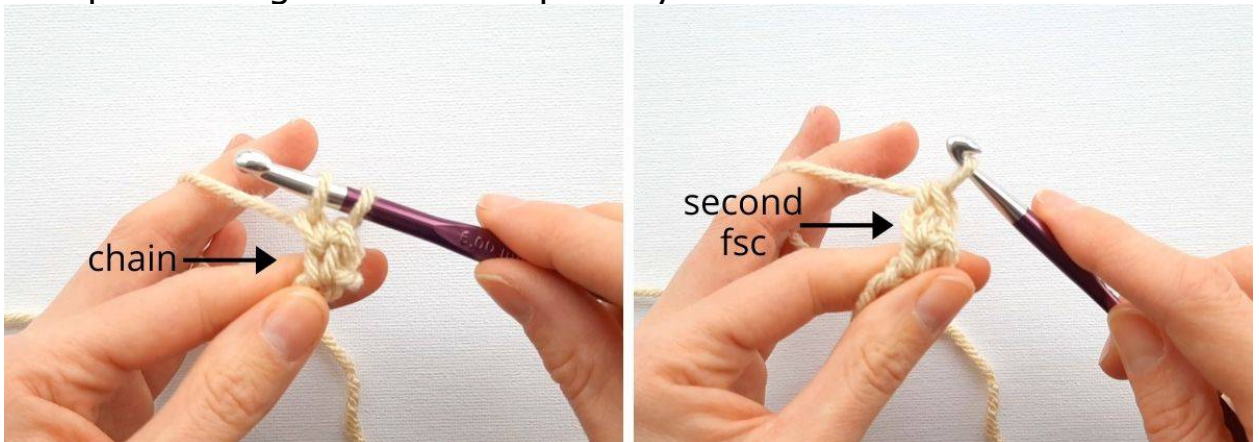
3. Yarn over and pull through the two loops on your hook. First fsc made.



4. Insert hook into extra "chain" made in Step 2. Yarn over and pull up a loop. **[2 loops on hook]**



5. Yarn over and pull through the first loop on hook i.e. ch 1. This is the next "chain" in your foundation row. Yarn over and pull through the two loops on your hook. 2nd fsc made.



6. Repeat Steps 4 and 5 until desired row length is reached.
