## Bashful Baby Hat \& Booties

## Offerrschners

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SKILL LEVEL:
Intermediate

FINISHED SIZE: Hat Circumference: $16{ }^{\prime \prime}(41 \mathrm{~cm})$ Length of booties: $31 / 2(8.9 \mathrm{~cm})$

MATERIALS: - Herrschners ${ }^{\circledR}$ Baby Sparkle
-Color of choice ( $3 \mathrm{oz} / 85 \mathrm{~g}$ )


YOU WILL NEED:

- Size D-3 $(3.25 \mathrm{~mm})$ crochet hook or size to obtain gauge
- Size E-4 (3.5mm)
- Tapestry needle


## GAUGE:

16 dc and 10 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10.2 \mathrm{~cm})$ with size D-3 hook Exact gauge is essential for your project to be proper size. As you begin your project, make a sample swatch per the instructions using the recommended yarn and hook. After you complete the swatch, measure it, counting your stitches and rows carefully. If your swatch is larger or smaller than specified, change the hook size and make another swatch to get the correct gauge. Keep trying until you find the hook size that will give you the specified gauge.

## STITCH GUIDE:

Chain (ch), slip stitch (sl st), single crochet (sc), half double crochet (hdc), double crochet (dc)
dc2tog (double crochet 2 together): ( Y , insert hook in next st, yo, pull Ip through, yo, pull through 2 lps on hook) twice, yo, pull through all Ips on hook. (1 st decreased)
cl (cluster): (Yo and draw up a Ip, yo and draw through 2 lps on hook) 3 times in next dc, yo and draw through all lps on hook.
magic circle: Form a circle with the end not attached to the ball on the left side of the circle. Insert hook in center of circle and yo from yarn that is attached to the ball, pull through center and ch 1 . Follow instructions in pat. When you have finished completing the number of sts that the pat calls for, then slowly pull the end not attached to the ball to close the circle.

DIRECTIONS:
Booties:
Sole:
Ch 14.
Rnd 1 (RS): Dc in fourth ch from hook, dc in each of next 9 chs, 5 dc in last ch, working into rem Ip on opposite side of ch, dc in each of next $9 \mathrm{chs}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in last ch; join with sl st to top of ch 3 .
Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in same sp as last $s \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc , dc in each of next 9 dc , 2 dc in each of next 5 dc , dc in each of next 9 dc , 2 dc in each of last 3 dc ; join with sl st to top of ch 3 .

## Upper Sole:

Rnd 1: Ch 1, working in back lps only of each st, sc in same sp as last s st , scin each of next 12 sts , hdc in each of next 3 sts, dc in each of next 4 sts, hdc in each of next 3 sts, sc in each of next 15 sts; join with $s \mathrm{~s} \mathrm{st}$ to first sc .
Rnd 2: Ch 3, dc in same sp as last slst, dc in each of next 16 sts, (dc2tog) twice, dc in each of next $15 \mathrm{sts}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st, dc in last st; join with sl st to top of ch 3 .
Rnd 3: Ch 3, dc in each of next 16 sts, (dc2tog) twice, dc in each of last 17 sts; join with sl st to top of ch 3 .
Rnd 4: Ch 1 , sc in same sp as last $s 1 s t$, sc in each of next 11 sts, hdc in each of next 2 sts, (dd2tog) 4 times, hdc in each of next 2 sts , 5 c in each of next 12 sts; join with sl st to first sc. ( 32 sts)
Rnd 5 (Eyelets): Ch 4 (counts as first dc, ch 1), sk first st, *dc in next st, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * around, slst to third ch of ch 4 to join.
Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in same sp as lasts $15 t$, ${ }^{*}$ ch 2, sk next ch-1 sp, clin next st, ch 2, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next dc ; rep from * around, ending with ch 2 , sk last ch-1 sp, sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

## Ties (make 2):

Using size E-4 hook, holding 2 strands of yarn tog, make a ch 12 " long. Fasten off. Weave Ties through Eyelet Rnd and tie.

## Hat:

Make a magic circle.
Rnd 1: Work 16 dc in center of circle; join with sl st to first dc.
Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), 2 dc in next dc, (dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc) to end; join with sl st to first dc. (24 dc)
Rnd 3: Ch 3, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, (dc in next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc) to end; join with $s$ st to first dc. (32 dc)
Rnd 4: Ch 3, dc in next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, (dc in next $3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc ) to end; join with sl st to first dc. (40 dc)
Rnd 5: Ch 3, dc in next $3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, (dc in next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc) to end; join with sl st to first dc. ( 48 dc )
Rnd 6: Ch 3, dc in next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, (dc in next $5 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc) to end; join with slst to first dc. ( 56 dc )
Rnd 7: Ch 3, dc in next $5 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, (dc in next $6 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc) to end; join with sl st to first dc. ( 64 dc )
Rep Rnd 7 until Hat measure 6 " from beg.
Next Rnd (Eyelets): Ch 4, sk first st, *dc in next st, ch 1 , sk next st; rep from * around, $s l$ st to third ch of ch 4 to join.
Next Rnd: Ch 1 , sc in same sp as last sl st, *ch 2, sk next ch-1 sp, cl in next dc, ch 2, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next dc; rep from * around, ending with ch 2, sk last ch-1 sp, sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Tie:
Using size E-4 hook, holding 2 strands of yarn tog, make a ch 30 " long. Fasten off. Weave ties through Eyelet Rnd and tie.

## Finishing:

Weave in ends.
